

With a 6mm thickness and optional clear or obscure finish, WIRETEK is a straightforward replacement for most Georgian Wire Glass glazing. Using WIRETEK can reduce the risks and challenges associated with working with traditional glass, including working at height.

Custom lengths of up to 6m and alternative thicknesses can be ordered.
